

Mobile Phone Guidelines for Camp David

Camp David is an opportunity for campers to build friendships and connect with peers and leaders as they enjoy shared experiences. These guidelines are intended to help to create a positive, relational culture at camp, allowing campers to connect with one another.

Parents are encouraged to refrain from sending their children on camp with a mobile phone. Phones are allowed on the buses to and from camp. Leaders will collect phones as campers get off the buses. These will be labelled and placed in the safe for the duration of camp.

If campers are seen using a phone during camp, these will be collected and put in the safe until the end of camp.

If you need to get in contact with your child, please contact one of the directors. The camp directors will have their mobile phone with them for the duration of camp. If a situation arises such that campers need to contact someone at home, they will also be able to use the director's phone to do so, in consultation with the director.

Exceptions to these guidelines include those campers who need easier access to their phone for their wellbeing. In these circumstances, the directors will discuss specific guidelines for individual phone use/access during camp. These phones will need to either stay with the directors or be kept in the camper's bag unless required.

Leaders are also encouraged to only use phones for camp related purposes.
